Alcohol and Drug Recovery Program for Men

Since 1971 we have operated a three-month residential program for addicted men which now has 54 beds

Halfway Program for Men

A 30 bed program for graduates who need additional help after their initial program

The Haven of Hope for Women

A three-month 34 bed recovery program on two campuses for addicted women which includes 6 beds for expectant mothers

Halfway Program for Women

A 13 bed program for graduates who need additional help after their initial program

Hope House

A house on the women's campus reserved for women and their small children with no other safe place to go while their mothers are on our programs

A Step-Up Program for Men and Women

A six-month extended stay program for graduates who need additional help after their initial program.

G.E.D. and Literacy Classes

A large percentage of men and women who attend these classes graduate with their GED while on our program.

Welcome Home Family Counseling Program

A ministry to the loved ones of our clients which includes marriage and family counseling

Jail Ministry

A special weekly ministry of love to those who are incarcerated which includes counseling and worship services.

Crises Ministry

Meeting the physical and spiritual needs of homeless and destitute families in the Mobile area
